1. Heard learned counsel for applicant, learned APP for the Respondent-State and learned counsel for Respondent No.2.
2. Learned counsel for Respondent No.2 submits that the co-accused who have been released on bail are not appearing before the trial Court. Hence, charge is not framed.
3. Considering the submission of learned counsel for Respondent No.2, the learned trial Court is requested to issue Non-bailable warrant order against the co-accused, who are remained absent before the trial Court and frame the charge as early as

possible. The applicant is behind bar for more than two and half years.

4. Learned counsel for applicant on instructions seeks leave to withdraw this application with liberty to file a fresh bail application after four months.

5. Considering the submission of learned counsel for applicant Application is allowed to be withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

6. Bail Application is dismissed and disposed of as withdrawn.

7. As the learned counsel for the Respondent No.2 appointed through legal-aid, professional Fees of Rs.10,000/- be paid to him.
