The learned Advocate appearing for Respondents raises objection that since order of rejection of plaint has been passed by trial Court in exercise of powers under Order 7 Rule 11 of Code of Civil Procedure, Appeal needs to be filed challenging said order and Civil Revision Application is not maintainable.
