1. We expressed that the remedy of the petitioner is to approach the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal under the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that appropriate application will be filed before the Tribunal.

2. In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to pursue the application before the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal.

3. Since the period spent in prosecuting the petition is *bona fide*, the same be considered sympathetically if the objection is raised as regards the limitation in challenging the impugned order before the Tribunal.

4. Keeping all contentions open, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
