1. Heard learned counsel for applicant and learned APP for the Respondent-State.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is behind bar for more than four years. Though charge has been framed, no witness is examined. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant be permitted to withdraw this application with liberty to file a fresh application after four months if there is no progress in trial.
3. Considering the submission of learned counsel for applicant as well as long incarceration of the applicant, the applicant is
