1. The applicant is seeking relaxation of conditions imposed by this Court (Coram : Madhav J. Jamdar, J.) by order dated 17th December, 2024 i.e. condition nos. (b) and (d) in the operating order, which reads as under :

(b) The Applicant shall not enter the Kolhapur district after being released on bail, except for reporting to the Investigating officer, if called, and for attending the trial.

(d) The Applicant shall report to the Karad Police Station, District-Satara once every week i.e. on every Sunday between 11.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m.
