ORDER

- I. The Impugned order dated 26th August, 2025 passed below Exhibit-26 by the learned Family Court, Kolhapur in Cri. M.A. No.6 of 2024 is hereby quashed and set aside.
 - II. The petitioner and respondent shall file their affidavits of assets and liabilities as per the ratio laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of *Rajnish Vs. Neha*.
 - III. The respondent shall answer the interrogatives as undertaken by her in her affidavit-in-reply.
 - IV. The trial Court is requested to dispose off the pending applications as early as possible.
4. Writ Petition is disposed off.
