1. Mr. Lokesh Zade, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner in
Writ Petition No.1707 of 2018 states that the Petitioner has sent a

Accordingly, Writ Petition No.4445 of 2014 is disposed of as the same has become infructuous.

As per Order dated 8th August 2019 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.4451 of 2014 and Writ Petition No.4445 of 2014, the Writ Petition No.4451 of 2014 is disposed of in terms of the said Order dated 8th August 2019 and in view of the statement made by Petitioner – Sarfaraj Moinuddin Patel as recorded in this order.

6. Thus, all the Writ Petitions and Criminal Application are disposed of in above terms with no order as to costs.
