1. Heard learned counsel for applicant, learned APP for the Respondent-State and learned counsel for respondent no. 2.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant on instructions seeks leave to withdraw the application with liberty to file fresh bail application before the Trial Court as directed by this Court.
