1. We are informed that the Appeal is listed before the respondent No.3 for hearing on 11th December 2025. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1 appears and assured that the respondent No.1 will co-operate and will not ask for any unnecessary adjournment.

2. Affidavit-in-reply, if any, to be filed by the respondent no.1 within one week from today before the respondent no.3. The petitioner also shall co-operate and not ask for any unnecessary
