1. Heard Mr. Patil, learned Counsel for the Petitioners and Mr. Naik, learned A.G.P, for Respondent – State.
2. The impugned order dated 13th October, 2023 is at **“Exhibit E”**. The proposal made for approval of appointment of Petitioner No.1 as “Junior Clerk” was rejected by the impugned order. The reasons for rejection of the proposal have been stated in the impugned order. However, Management was not given an opportunity of curing deficiencies in the proposal.
3. Learned A.G.P made an attempt to justify the impugned order.

4. We find that no opportunity was given to the Management to cure deficiencies. In such view of the matter, we are of the opinion that the impugned order dated 13th October, 2023 at page 24 of the Paper Book should be treated as “Show Cause Notice” to the Management. The Management to cure the deficiencies within a period of four weeks from today. If there are any further deficiencies, Education Officer to inform the Management within a period of six weeks from today. Management to cure further deficiencies within a period of four weeks from the date of intimation. Show Cause Notice be decided within a period of sixteen weeks from today.

5. The Petition is disposed of. No order as to costs.
