1. Heard learned counsel for the revisional applicant and learned counsel for Respondent No.1. Both learned counsel submit that the matter is settled between the parties out of the Court. They tendered consent terms. It is taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification.

2. This Court inquired with the applicant Yunus Mulla and Respondent/Complainant Sushil Premchand Vanjani about terms mentioned in the Consent Terms. Both have agreed that they have read the consent terms and signed on it.

3. Considering the submissions of both the learned counsel and in view of the consent terms, application is allowed.
4. The conviction imposed on the applicant by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Court Room No.5, Kolhapur in Summary Criminal Case No.8456 of 2023 is quashed and set aside.
5. Bail bonds of the applicant stands cancelled.
6. Applicant is acquitted from the charges levelled against him.
7. Criminal Revision Application is disposed off.
