1. The proposal forwarded by the Management dated 3rd October, 2022, received by Respondent No.2 on 3rd October, 2022, is said to be pending. The learned AGP submits that he does not have instructions as to whether the proposal is decided or not. He submits that if it is still pending, it will be decided within a period of eight weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, this **Writ Petition is disposed off.**

3. We direct Respondent No.2, that if the proposal is still pending, all objections to the proposal shall be raised within a period of 15 days from today and shall be communicated to the Management on its E-mail address. The Management shall remove the deficiencies/cure the objections, within a further period of 30 days and re-submit the proposal. Thereafter, Respondent No.2 would decide the revised proposal on its own merits within a period 30 days. We make it clear that we have not expressed any opinion as regards the merits of the proposal.

4. If the proposal is rejected, the aggrieved party is at liberty to avail of a remedy, as is permissible in law. If the proposal is accepted, steps for grant of Shalarth-ID shall be expeditiously undertaken.
