1 Considering the fact that the impugned order passed by the Maharashtra State Waqf Tribunal merely remands the proceedings to the Waqf Board for being decided afresh after grant of opportunity of hearing to Respondent No.1, I am not inclined to entertain the Civil Revision Application filed by the Applicants.
