- 1) On 10.09.2025, the following order was passed:
- “1. None appears for the applicant, when the matter is called out for hearing.
 2. Even on earlier occasions i.e. 6 February 2024 and 7 March 2024, none appeared on behalf of the applicant. On 8 May 2024, the Advocate for the applicant appeared, when this Court issued notice to the respondent, returnable on 26 June 2024. Private service was also permitted.
