4. Until further orders, the approval granted to the present Petitioner, shall not be disturbed/ cancelled, without the leave of the

Court.

5. List Writ Petition (St.) No. 16209 of 2022, along with the present Writ Petition, on the returnable date.

6. Spare copies of the Petition paper-book shall be supplied, on or before 6th February, 2025, failing which, the ad-interim protection granted would stand vacated without reference to the Court, on 7th February, 2025.

7. All office objections, if any, to be removed, on or before 11th February, 2025, failing which, the Petition would stand dismissed without reference to the Court, on 12th February, 2025.
