1. The Petitioner seeks compassionate appointment since his father passed away while in service, on 7th January, 2017. The Petitioner has applied for compassionate appointment vide the first application dated 29th June, 2018. Further applications were also filed in a period of about three years that followed. Yet, no decision

has been taken by Respondent No.4 Private Management.

2. Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on **5th March, 2025**. The learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 and 2.

3. Until further orders, the Zilla Parishad would not appoint any candidate on compassionate basis, whose parent/bread earner has passed away after the passing of the Petitioner's father or who has applied after the Petitioner made his application.

4. All office objections, if any, to be removed on or before 13th February, 2025, failing which this Petition would stand dismissed without reference to the Court, on 14th February, 2025.
