2. Our attention is invited to the copy of communication dated 27.03.2024 addressed by the Naib-Tahsildar, S.D.O Office, Thane to the Tahsildar Thane. Accordingly, the Tahsildar was asked to submit his explanation to the complaint made by the Petitioners to the Sub Divisional Officer, which was the subject matter of the order dated 27.03.2024.
3. It is the grievance of the Petitioners that despite initiating action on the complaint made by the Petitioners, no further

decision is taken on the complaint.
