1. The learned Advocate for the Petitioners submits that the direction issued to the Management by the Competent Authority has been complied with. Accordingly, the salary of Respondent No.2, as well as that of the other employees, can now be released by Respondent No.3.

2. Since the Petitioners pray for disposal of the Petition, and as Respondent No.3 has not been issued with notice, we would only observe that Respondent No.3 would scrutinize as to whether the Petitioners have complied with the order dated 5th December, 2023 and if the said order has

been complied with, Respondent No.3 shall issue affirmative directions for the release of salary to those who are eligible to receive it. If there is no legal impediment, the salary shall be released prior to the Diwali festival.

3. In view of the above and on the request of the Petitioners, **this Writ Petition is disposed off.**
