Mr. Chandrakant Shah, very fairly states that he does not wish to presently press this Petition or rather he seeks leave to withdraw this Petition given the decision of co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of *All India IDBI Officers Association & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors.*¹ and *Mrinmayee Rohit Umrotkar Vs. Union of India & Ors.*². However, he seeks liberty to file fresh proceedings to challenge the impugned orders, in case, the above two decisions, which have already been appealed before the
