2. By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to the respondent No.1-Maharashtra Medical Council ('MMC') to decide the

petitioner's complaint filed on 20th October 2015 and again on 15th February 2024.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1-MMC, on instructions, states that reasonable time be granted to enable the respondent No.1- MMC to decide the petitioner's aforesaid two complaints.

4. Accordingly, since the complaint is pending since 2015 and similar complaint is made in 2024, we direct the respondent No.1-MMC to decide both the said complaints, as expeditiously as possible, and in any event within 6 months from the date of receipt of this order.

5. Petition is allowed in the aforesaid terms and is accordingly disposed of.
