The petitioner challenges the legality of the seizure memo dated 7 November, 2023 issued by respondents whereby the petitioner's vehicle being a Light Goods Vehicle - public carrier made by Mahindra Maxitruck bearing registration No. MH - 43 - BB - 0288 is detained by the RTO at Mumbai, on the failure of the petitioner to comply with the directions of this Court in the order dated 3 March 2004 passed in Notice of Motion No.57 of 2004 in Writ Petition No.1762 of 1999 (Exhibit "H").

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the petitioner is ready and willing to comply with all the terms and conditions as set out in the said order passed by this Court as also as referred in the order passed in Writ Petition (L) No.10853 of 2024 dated 5 April 2024, so as to

deposit an amount of Rs. 10,000/- as also to furnish an undertaking.

3. On such compliance being made within a period of three days from the order being made available, the respondents are directed to release the petitioner's vehicle forthwith.
4. The petition stands disposed of in the above terms. No costs.
