- 2.** Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner is willing to make an application for One Time Settlement ("OTS") to the Respondent No.3-Bank. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner wants to put an end to the litigation by settling the dues, as there are other proceedings filed by the Respondent-Bank before

the DRT Court as well for recovery. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that within a period of one week from today, the OTS proposal will be submitted as per the G.R. dated 4th July 2024.
