ORDER:

1. Learned counsel for the appellant has tendered the decision of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of *K.C. Ninan V/s. Kerala State Electricity Board and Others*¹ and the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Electricity Supply Code and Standards of Performance of Distribution Licensees including Power Quality) Regulations, 2021.
