Dr. Warunjikar, learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent – Contemnor would submit that after the communication dated 10th January 2025 was addressed to learned AGP that the amount is being deposited, subsequently the challan was issued, and the amount came to be deposited on 23rd January 2025.
