1) Heard Mr. Nargolkar, the learned counsel appearing for Respondents. He would submit that an amount of Rs. 38,03,175/- had already been paid to the Petitioner. He would submit that after receipt of declaration form from the Petitioner for provident fund, further amount of Rs. 6,58,417/- would also be paid to the Petitioner. Ms. Deshpande would dispute the figures computed by the Respondents. In my view, such a dispute cannot be adjudicated in contempt jurisdiction by this Court. Petitioner would be at liberty to take appropriate steps in respect of the disputed figures.
