1. Heard learned Advocate for the Contempt Petitioners / Claimants in the Claims Petitions before the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal – Mumbai (“**MACT – Mumbai**”). Their claim was decided. During the pendency of the First Appeal, there was direction given by the learned Single Judge. It is in two parts:-

- (i) Withdrawal is allowed for part of the amount
