1. By this Miscellaneous Civil Application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 the Applicant-wife seeks transfer of proceedings bearing Petition A No.1983 of 2024 from learned Family Court, Pune to learned Family Court, Kolhapur.

8. Miscellaneous Civil Application is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
