2. Mr. Harshvardhan Tripathi, the respondent, appears in-person.

The respondent submits that he has no objection to transfer the proceedings i.e. DV-265/2023 pending on the file of Judicial Magistrate, First Class, 24th Court, Borivali, to the Family Court at Bandra, where the Petition A-292/2024 filed by him for a decree of dissolution of marriage is pending.
