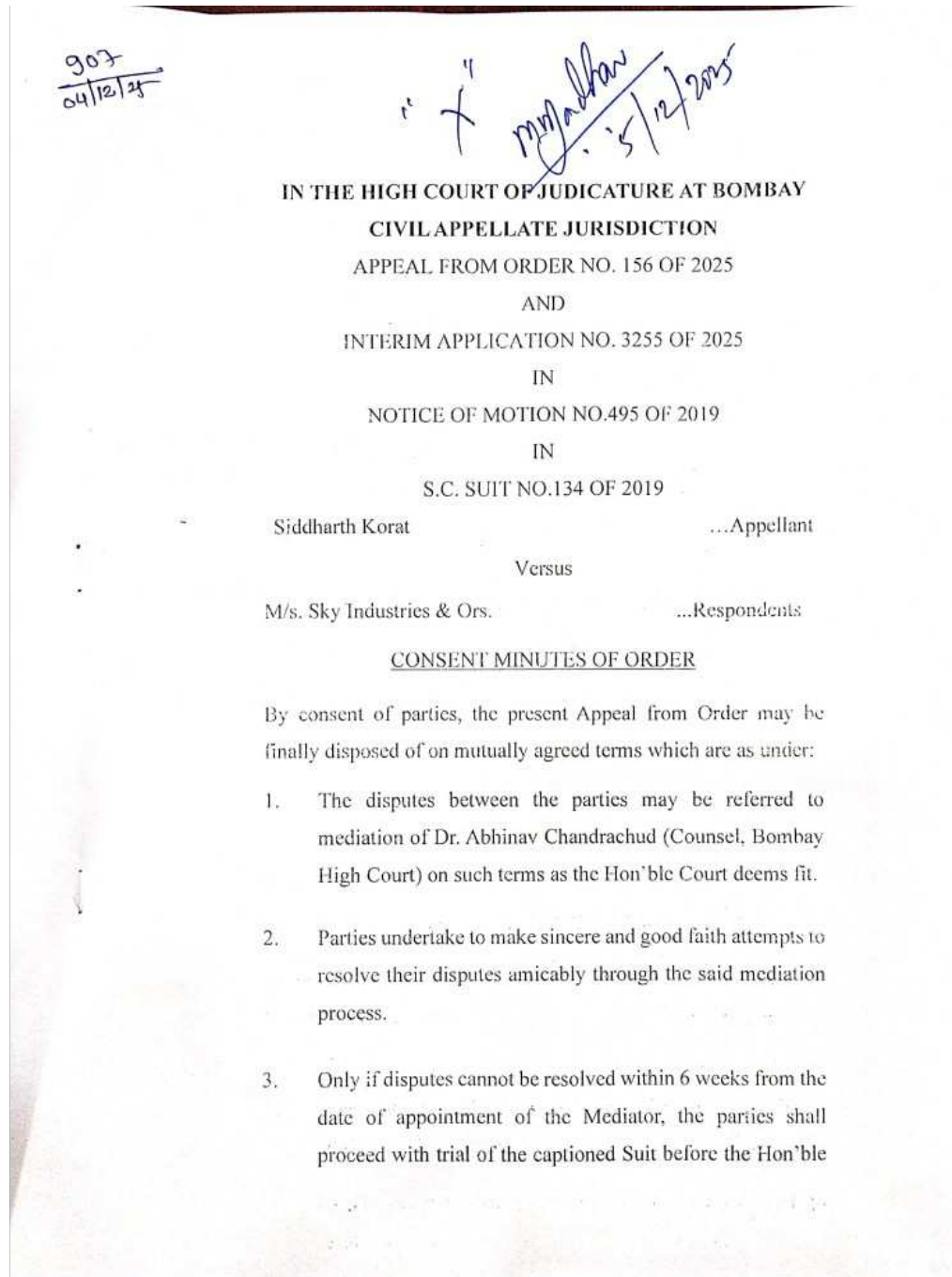

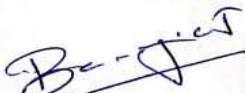
3. Consent Minutes of Order are running into 2 pages. For the sake of reference, Consent Minutes of order are scanned and reproduced below:-
