2) In Writ Petition No.9045 of 2025, the Petitioner-Wife has sought enhancement of the maintenance amount for their daughter, in Writ Petition No.53 of 2025, the Wife has challenged the access order and in Criminal Writ Petition No.232 of 2025, the Wife has challenged the order of rejection of her Application seeking amendment to the DV Application.
