1) Petitioners i.e. Husband, Father in law, Mother in law and Brother in law of Respondent No.2 have filed this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of C.C. No. 5002/PW/2023, pending on the file of Additional Judicial Magistrate First Class, 24th Court, Borivali at Mumbai, arising out of C.R. No. 1803 of 2022 dated 20th December 2022, registered with Malvani Police Station, Mumbai, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 504 and 506 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, with the consent of Respondent No.2, the informant.

2) Advocate Mr. Sahani appearing for Respondent No.2, tendered across the Bar her affidavit dated 30th July 2025, duly affirmed before the Notary Public. It is stated therein that, Petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2 have filed Consent Terms dated 3rd September 2024 in C.C.
