1. We have heard the learned Advocate for the Petitioners and the learned APP. The Petitioners are the mother-in-law and the brother-in-law of the Complainant who has lodged the First Information Report bearing no.0262 of 2024, registered with the Vimantol Police Station, Pune City on 5th June, 2024.
