Having heard learned Counsel for the appellant, learned A.P.P, and learned Counsel appearing for the respondent No.2 - complainant and having perused the impugned order, case diary and statements of the witnesses, when this Court expressed its disinclination to interfere in the impugned order dated 2nd December, 2024 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge by
