

getting forged Aadhar Card etc. The accused No.2 was also found to be citizen of Bangladesh and residing in India on the basis of forged documents, i.e., Aadhar Card etc.

4. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is in jail for one and half years. On instructions, learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant does not want to contest the case on merits and wants to plead guilty. The learned counsel for the applicant however, submits that the trial Court, be directed to impose the sentence of imprisonment already undergone by the applicant, so that after his release he can be deported.

5. The learned APP for the respondent/State submits that appropriate order be passed.

6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, the following order is passed:

ORDER

A) If the applicant pleads guilty to the charges, then the trial Court shall impose the punishment of imprisonment the applicant has already undergone till that date.

B] The concerned authorities shall take steps to deport the applicant.

7. The Application is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
