1. This is an application for Anticipatory Bail.
2. The applicant is apprehending his arrest in Crime No. 572 of 2024 registered at Dindoshi Police Station, for the offences punishable under Sections 406 & 420 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
3. Today, by the separate order, in Anticipatory Bail Application No.2351 of 2024, I have allowed the Anticipatory Bail Application of the co-accused by observing that the dispute between the parties, *prima-facie*, appears to be civil in nature.

4. In that view of the matter, I am inclined to release the present applicant on anticipatory bail. In the result, the following order is passed :

ORDER

- a) The Application is allowed.
- b) In the event of arrest of the applicant in connection with Crime No. 572 of 2024 registered at Dindoshi Police Station, for the offences punishable under Sections 406 & 420 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, the applicant be released on bail on furnishing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount.
