1. Mr. Sarkar, learned counsel for the applicant submits that a sum of Rs.2 lakhs has been deposited in this Court. He seeks liberty to add the first informant as party respondent no. 2.
2. Liberty granted as prayed for. Amendment to be carried out **forthwith**. If the amendment is not carried out forthwith, the anticipatory bail application will stand dismissed without further reference to this Court.
3. Issue notice to respondent no. 2 returnable on **17 June 2025**. Apart from the court notice, the applicant is also permitted to serve the respondent no.2 by private service, by all permissible modes of service and file affidavit of service before the next date of the hearing.

4. APP to serve a copy of the anticipatory bail application on the respondent no.2 through the investigating officer.
5. Stand over to **17 June 2025**.
6. Interim protection granted earlier to continue till the next date of hearing.
