Mr, Aniket Vagal, the learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that in compliance with the directions issued in the order dated 16 December 2024 and and its further extension on 31 January 2025, the Applicant has attended the office of the Investigating Officer. He further submits that Accused No. 1, who is the alleged kingpin, his Anticipatory Bail Application has already been confirmed by this Court.
