This interim application is filed by the first informant, seeking intervention in the anticipatory bail application.

2. In view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of *Jagjeet Singh & Ors. vs. Ashish Mishra @Monu & Anr., in Criminal Appeal No. 632 of 2022*, it is held that a victim is entitled to
