1. Heard Mr. Ingle, learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant. He states that if the Criminal Appeal is heard finally, then he has instructions to withdraw the Interim Application. He states that as the Applicant has completed about 23 months of the imprisonment, the Criminal Appeal be placed for final hearing.
