1. Heard learned counsel for the Applicant, learned counsel for Respondent No.1 (SPP) and learned APP for the State.
2. By this application, the Applicant is seeking relaxation of condition Nos.(f) and (g) imposed by this Court (Coram: Bharati Dangre, J.) vide order dated 20th August, 2022.
3. By the said conditions, the Applicant was directed to

attend the trial Court regularly without seeking any adjournment, and if there is default of two consecutive dates to appear before the trial Court, it will be the ground to cancel the bail. Learned counsel for the Applicant further submits that evidence of the Applicant is over and Applicant has turned into approver, hence his attendance before the trial Court is not required. Hence, requested to allow the application.

ORDER
