

3. On the other hand, the learned A.P.P. for the Respondent-State submits that considering the nature of crime, the above condition was imposed. It is submitted that witnesses are from Solapur district and thus the condition may not be relaxed.

4. This Court while releasing the applicants on bail has observed that, it is a case of road rage. The applicants are women. It appears that they are not the main accused. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to relax the condition in question. In the result, the following order is passed :

ORDER

- i. The application is allowed;
- ii. The condition that applicants shall not enter the Solapur district is hereby relaxed.
- iii. The applicants instead of Bharti Vidyapeeth Police Station as directed by this Court shall attend the Sangola Police Station twice in a month i.e. on first and third Saturday between 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. till conclusion of trial.
- iv. The applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
- v. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
