1. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties. Given the fact that the respondent nos.4 to 7 have approached the Debts Recovery Tribunal raising a challenge to the steps taken by petitioner for enforcement of its security interest, it is not necessary to entertain the writ petition. Needless to observe that it would be open for the petitioner to move the respondent no.3 Tahsildar for seeking enforcement and implementation of the order passed under Section 14 of the Securitization and

Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002. If such application is moved, same shall be considered in accordance with law. Keeping all points raised in the writ petition open, it is disposed of as not entertained.
