1. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. On instructions the learned counsel for the Petitioners has tendered an undertaking on behalf of the Petitioners wherein it has been stated that out of the outstanding amount of Rs.40,00,000/-, amount of Rs.10,00,000/- was paid to the Respondent No.3 on 28/02/2025. Further amount of Rs.15,00,000/- would be paid by 25/03/2025 and the balance amount of Rs.15,00,000/- will be paid by 25/04/2025.
