1. Challenge in this writ petition arises out of supersession of a managing committee.
2. On the date of filing of the writ petition, the revisional authority was not available; however, now the revisional authority is available. Considering the nature of the order passed against the petitioners, in my opinion, the ad-interim relief granted by this Court deserves to be continued till the disposal of the revision application and for period of two weeks thereafter.
