2. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned Addl.G.P. waives notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 & 5-State and seeks time to take instructions. Mr. Nandimath waives notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.2 to 4 and seeks time to file an affidavit-in-reply. Time granted.
