1. We have passed the orders granting ad-interim reliefs on this petition on 9 April 2025. Thereafter on 16 April 2025 when the proceedings were listed before us, we had permitted amendment as also made the following observations in paragraph 3 of the said order:

“3. We may also observe that actions were taken despite the interim order passed by us. In such context, remedial measures, be taken in the electronic customer data.”
