1. We have noticed the urgency involved in this matter. It goes without saying that Government Resolution dated 15th March, 2024, ought to be in tune with Section 25 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

4. The parties shall note that we would not be adjourning this matter on the returnable date, considering the urgency involved.

In the event, the Zilla Parishad is in the process of issuing orders of shifting these teachers from one section to another section or by declaring them surplus, which is to be effective from the academic year June, 2025-2026, we would appreciate if this process is not formalized since we are hearing the matter on 5th May, 2025.
