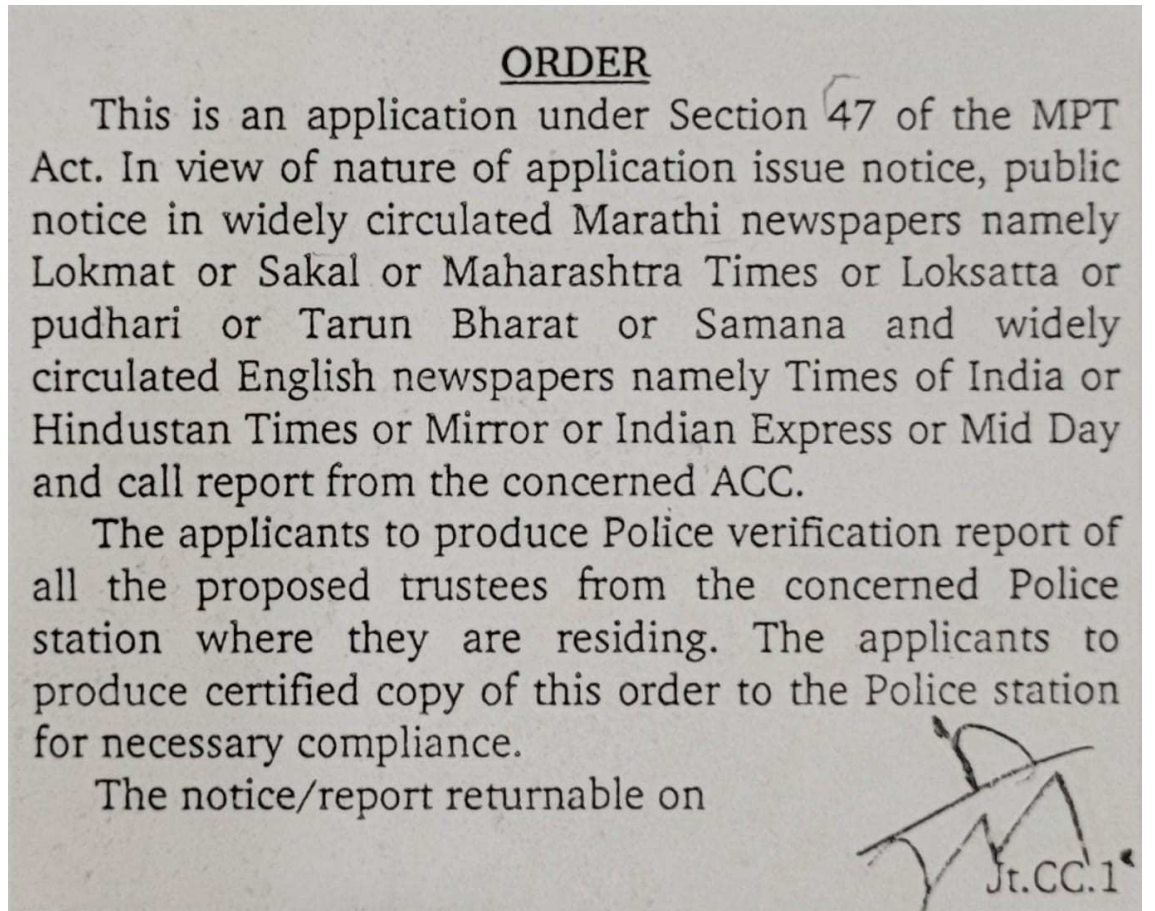

1. By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing and setting aside of the impugned order dated 21st January 2025 passed by the Joint Charity Commissioner, Mumbai. The said order is at page 51 of the petition.

2. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner the said order is not in consonance with the provisions of the Maharashtra

Public Trust Act and clearly reflects non-application of mind. It is further submitted that the impugned order is a pre-formatted order with no date or returnable date on it and as such shows non-application of mind.
