The only contention as urged on behalf of the petitioner is that the petitioner shall vacate the tenement within ten days from today and till that time no coercive action be taken of a forcible eviction. We accept the statement as made on behalf of the petitioner. Let an undertaking to that effect be placed on record by tomorrow 12 noon. If the undertaking is not filed and served on the advocate for the SRA, the respondents are free to take appropriate action which is already set into motion. On the undertaking

being filed, the petitioner shall unconditionally vacate the premises within ten days. The petition accordingly stand disposed of as the petitioner is not pressing any of the prayers as made in the petition.

3. The advocate for the SRA shall inform this order immediately to the concerned officials without waiting for the copy of this order.
