- 1.** Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner.
- 2.** The Revisional Authority has dismissed the Revision Application on the ground of non-compliance of the mandate contained in Section 154 (2A) of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act 1960.
- 3.** The learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has, as of date, deposited Rs.6,85,555/- as against the Certificate issued by the Deputy Registrar for recovery of a sum of Rs.6,37,703/-.

- 5.** Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 8th August 2025.
